

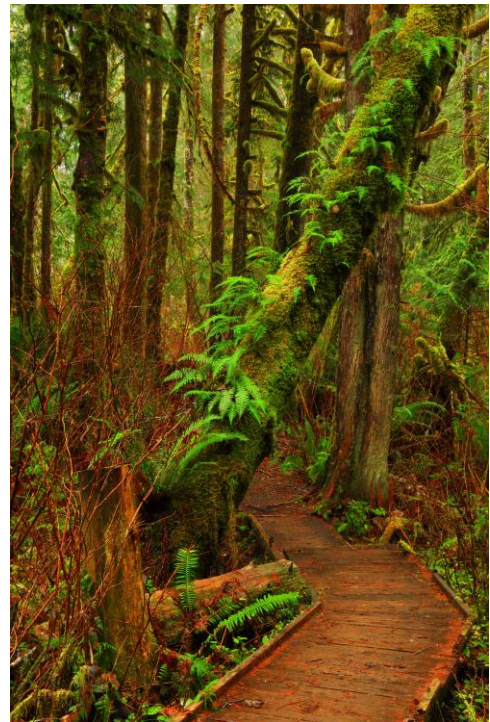
Highlights of the Wallace Falls Lesson

In the Wallace Falls Lesson, we begin with our outdoor classroom. During this time we set up the cameras correctly including Aperture Priority, ISO, White Balance, Advanced Color Settings and More. Then we go through all the professional shooting techniques including Depth of Field, Exposure Compensation, Aperture Control, Circular Polarizer, Split Neutral Density Filters and More.

We do this one step at a time, slowly, so every student understands each step. We practice, practice, practice. Then we head out in the field to put it into action at Small Falls.
